Under Wisconsin law, any registered voter who prefers to vote by absentee ballot for the November 3, 2020 General Election may do so. Many of the options below will allow you to request a ballot and vote from home.

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES

- October 21, 2020 The deadline to register to vote online (by 11:59 p.m.) or by-mail (postmarked). Go to MyVote.wi.gov.
- October 30, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. Register and vote at in-person absentee voting through October 30 in your municipal clerk's office. Bring your proof of residence and photo ID.
- **November 3, 2020** Go to your polling place on Election Day. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. 8:00 p.m. Bring proof of residence and your photo ID. Find your polling place at **MyVote.wi.gov**.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Apply online at MyVote.wi.gov.

- You may need to provide a picture of your photo ID and can use a smart phone to take a picture of it.
- The address on your ID does not need to be current.

INDEFINITELY CONFINED VOTERS

If you have difficulty getting to the polls due to age, illness, infirmity, or disability, you may request a ballot be sent to you for every election. This is the fastest method. You do not need to download a photo ID.

This process must be completed by 5:00 p.m. on October 30, 2020:

- 1. Go to **MyVote.wi.gov**. Click on Vote Absentee.
- 2. Enter your First Name, Last Name, and Date of Birth. Click on Search. Click on Request Absentee Ballot.
- 3. Check the box that allows you to verify that your address and name are correct. Before you click on Continue, make sure you check the box confirming that you are indefinitely confined.
- 4. Check box confirming that you are a qualified elector and certifying that all statements are true. Then, click on Request Ballot.
